Re: Public Information Hearing ~ Authority-to-Construct Air Quality Permit Modification Application #0902-M3 for American Cement

Dear Concerned Citizen,

American Cement has submitted an Authority-to-Construct Permit Modification Application (#0902-M3) to the Air Quality Division (Division) of the City of Albuquerque Environmental Health Department to increase hours of operation at their transfer station in order to operate continuously. The facility is located at 4702 Carlton St. NW, Albuquerque, New Mexico. Approval of the modification to their existing air quality permit is required before their operations can increase in Bernalillo County.

Since neighborhood members have shown a significant public interest in the proposed modification, a public information hearing will be held on **Tuesday, June 23, 2009, from 6:00 – 9:00 p.m., at the Albuquerque Convention Center, 401 2nd Street NW in the Picuris and Sandia Rooms, Westside Complex, Basement Level.** This facility was chosen to accommodate the significant public interest that has been expressed in this matter. Free parking will be provided in the Convention Center garage. Please inform the parking attendant that you are attending this hearing in order to have your parking validated.

American Cement representatives will present information on their application, the Air Quality Division staff will be available to explain the permit application process and answer questions, and the public will have an opportunity to ask questions and testify regarding the permit application.
